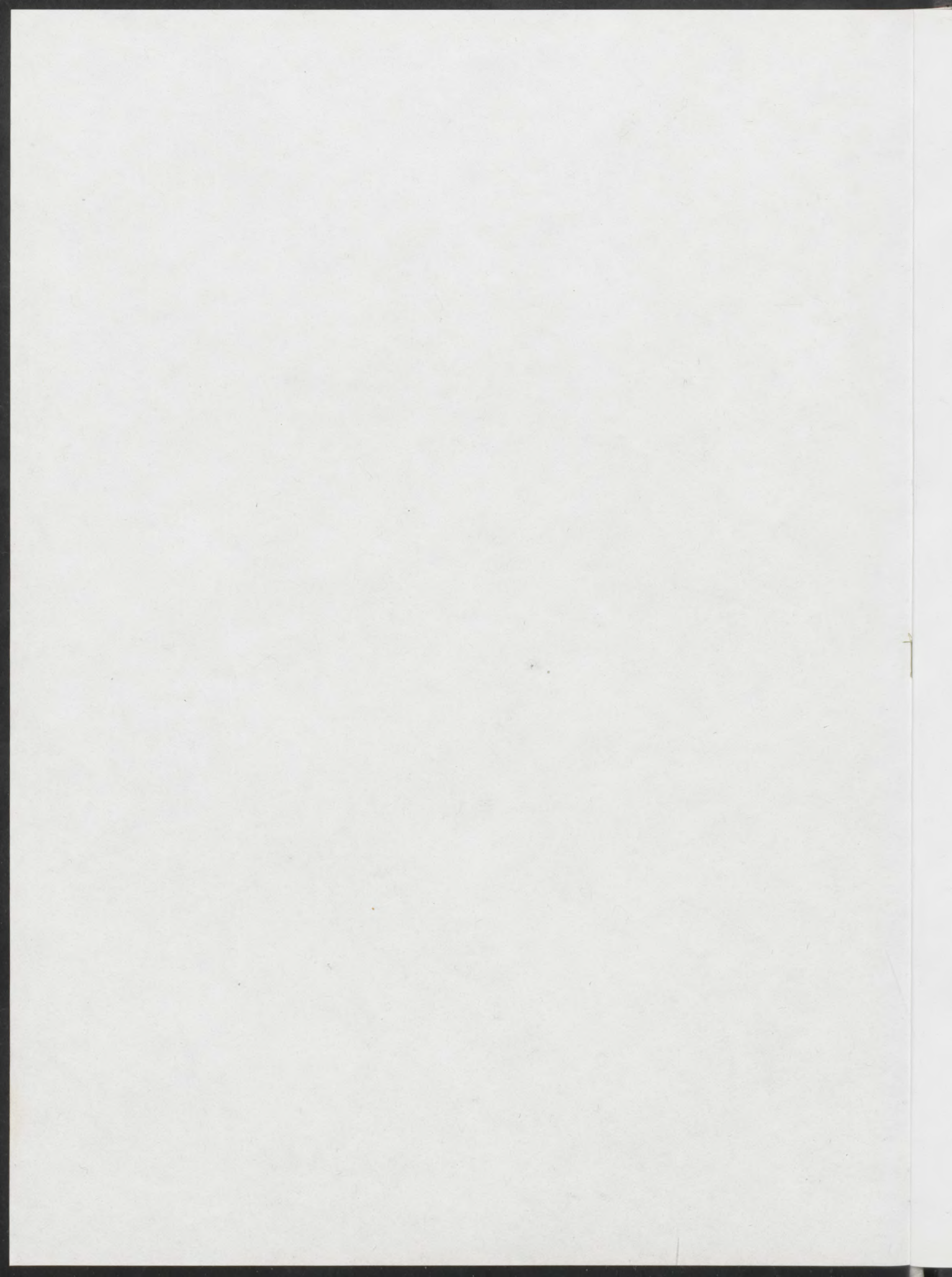

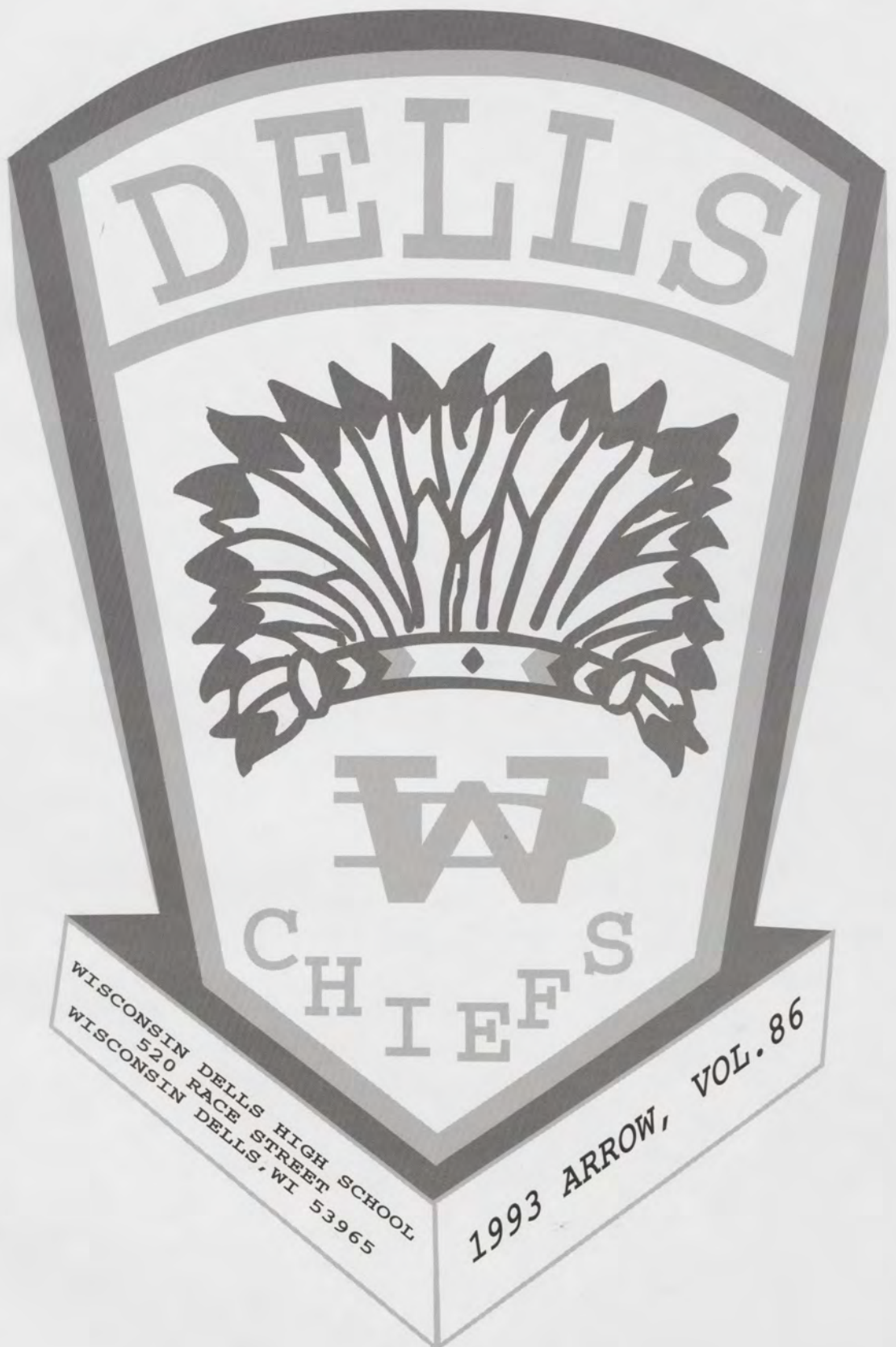

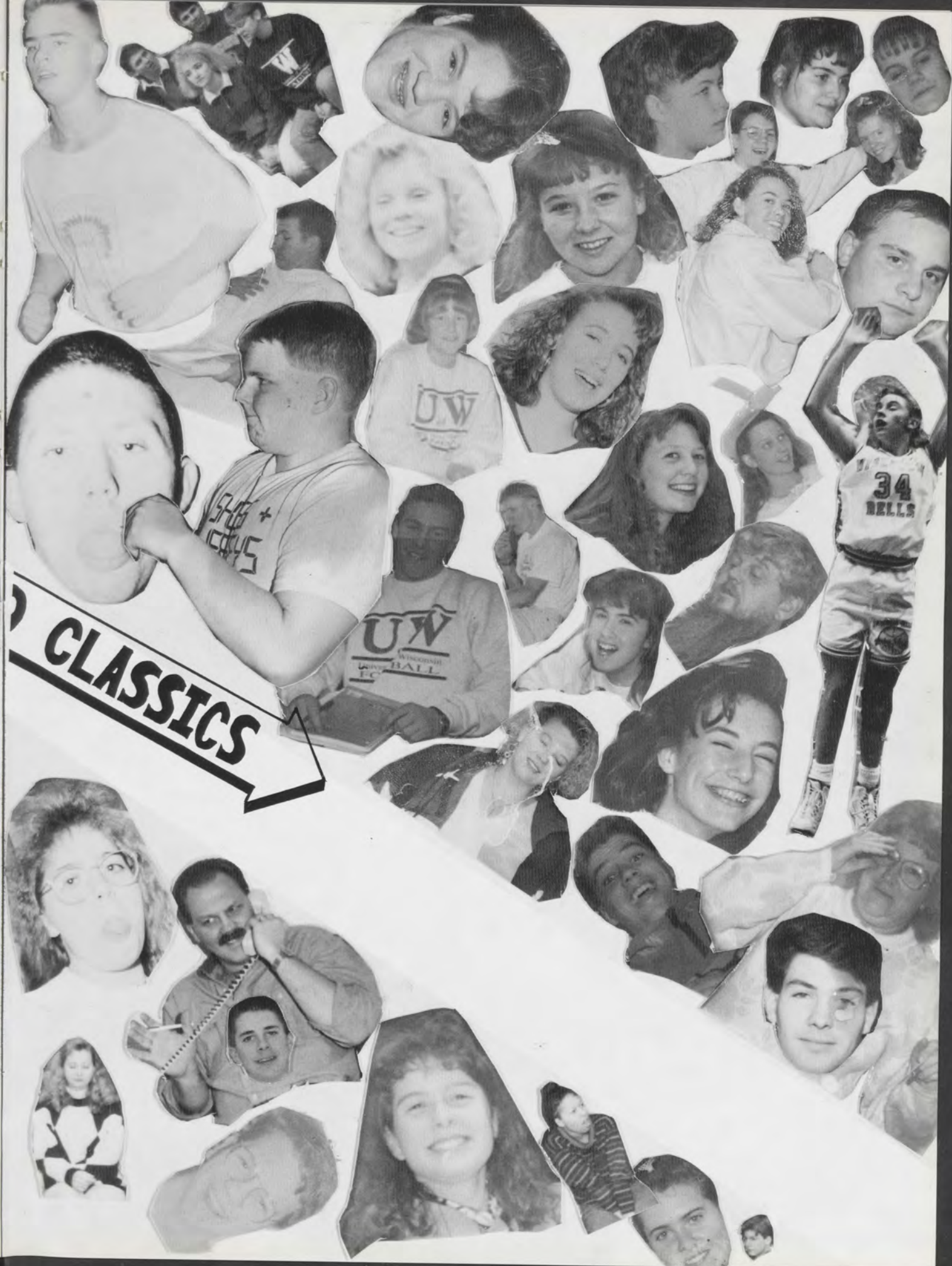

# THE WINNER OF THE SPIRIT TROPHY IS . . .

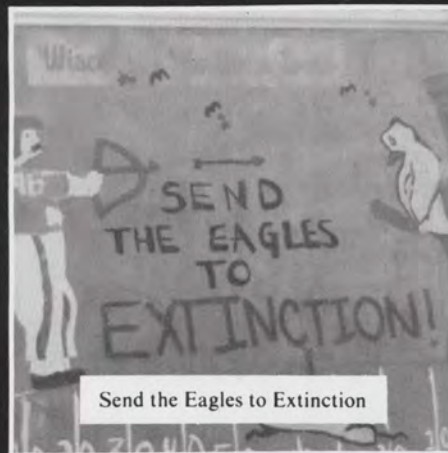

# Armed and Dangerous



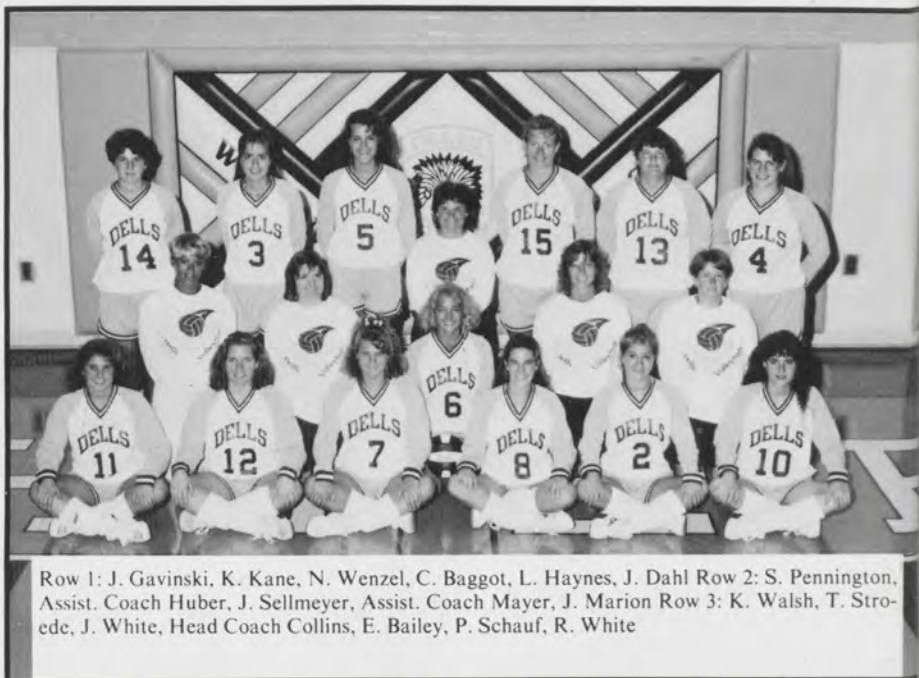

The success of the volleyball team has helped build gaining support and dedicated fans. The Dells ended up with a record of 9-3 and 2nd place in conference.

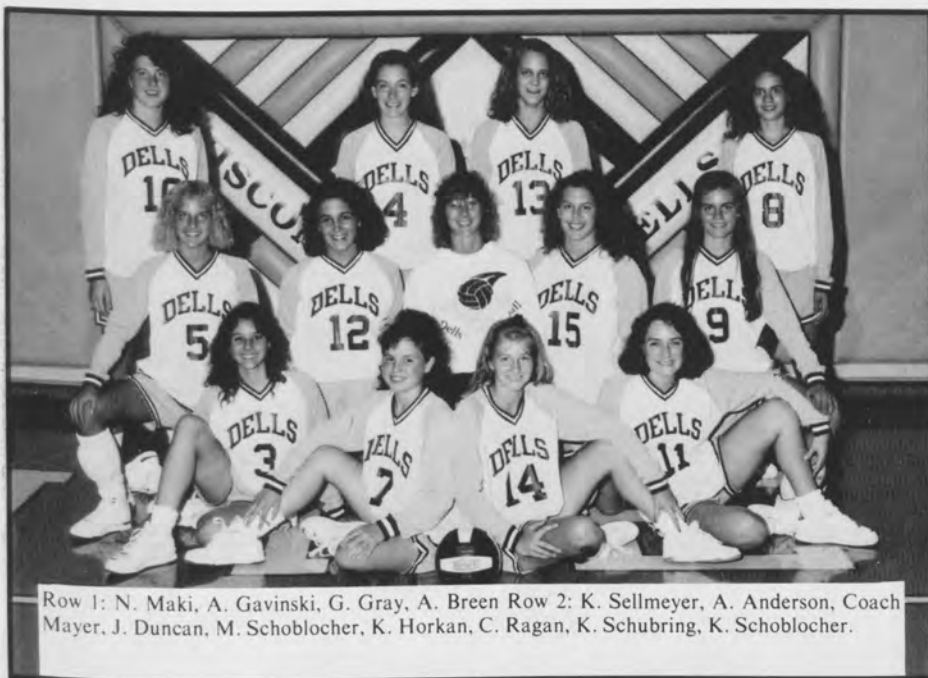

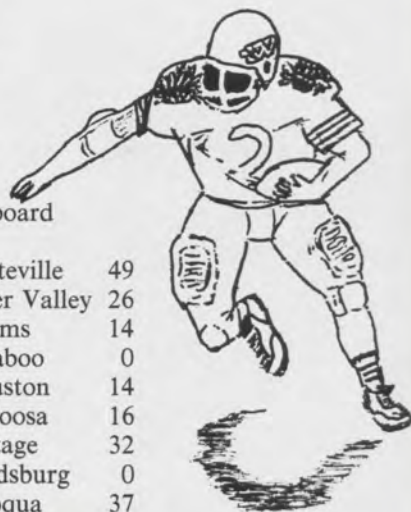


## Team on the Rise

Wisconsin Dells football proved to take some changes in its 1992 edition. First, a new head coach, Bryan Yager, who brought with him a new offense. An offense putting more emphasis of the run, a change from last year's pass orientated offense. Although the win-loss record of 2-7 was anything but a complete turn around, the manner in which the games were decided was. The heart-breaking loss to Adams in the Conference opener may have sent many teams in limbo, however the Chiefs came back to outslug Baraboo in a 6-0 victory the following week.

The season was highlighted by victories over conference rivals Baraboo and Reedsburg, where the option ground attack ran up over 200 yards in each game. At seasons end no one made excuses for what could have been, but the fact was that a conference record of 2-4, was literally inches

away from being 4-2. Against Adams a punt return for a touchdown was called back because of a penalty and second quarter field goal attempt versus Nekoosa dropped just short of the crossbar. A 2-7 overall record led many players into phases of frustration, but dedication, hard work, and tremendous courage displayed by the team throughout the season showed the true spirit of Dells football.
