Although we are still one year from our goal, graduation, we have already set our eyes on the finish line, as we enter the last lap of the race.





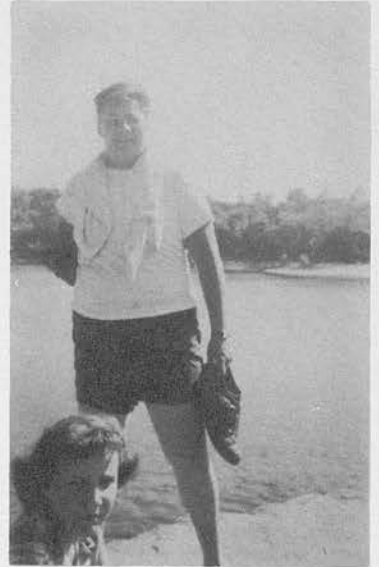
