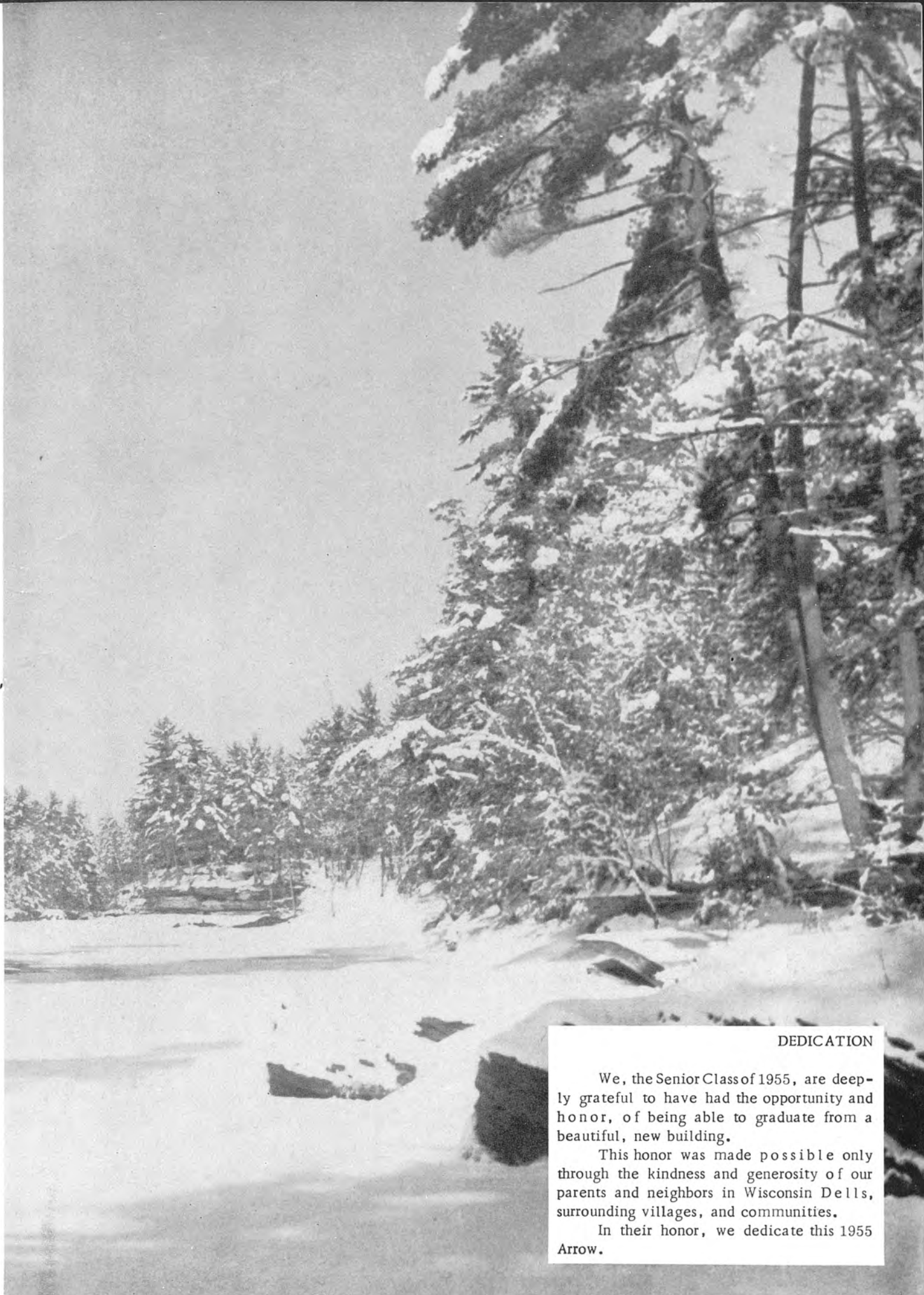


FOREWORD
